Creative Cricklewood invites you to a fascinating evening stroll down Cricklewood's Memory Lane. We are offering you two Heritage walks, one after the other.

WALK ONE - 7.00pm: TRAINS, PLANES AND COWS from the Millennium Green on Claremont Road. Led by local Artist Alistair Lambert and Carol Brooksbank. Taking us up to Clitterhouse Farm and back down to the Crown Hotel, with interesting facts and anecdotes relating to Cricklewood's farming and flying past.

WALK TWO - 8.15PM: COUNTY CRICKLEWOOD from the mezzanine floor of the Crown Moran. Led by Irish Historian and local Artist Bernard Canavan. Walking down to Kilburn Station and back. Discussing the rich Irish heritage of the area.

THROUGHOUT THE EVENING - AT THE CROWN MORAN (mezzanine floor) - COME FOR A STROLL DOWN MEMORY LANE AND SHOW YOUR OLD PHOTOS AND SHARE YOUR MEMORIES WITH US.

There will be a short film about Nora Marshall who has lived in her house in Temple Road since 1940. Through her memories she will give us an insight into her daily life in Cricklewood during and after the war.
